## ADOPT-A-GROUP HOME PROGRAM

The Kennedy Center's Adopt-A-Group Home program is a partnership uniting a group home with businesses, civic organizations and other community partners. Adoptive organizations are encouraged to enhance and maintain one of our 14 group homes scattered throughout neighborhoods in New Haven and Fairfield counties. Each of our homes provides a 24-hour supervised setting for as many as 8 individuals and is structured with their specialized needs in mind. Proper maintenance to our homes is vital to The Kennedy Center and its staff to ensure a comfortable and safe environment for all our residents, and funding provided by the State is limited in this area. The Adopt-A-Home partnership will greatly assist our group homes by helping us to effectively maintain the quality standards that have been established to better serve our individuals.

### PURPOSE:

The program will seek to build a relationship between a group home and a business or organization. It will provide resources to address the physical needs of the home and will in turn enhance the environment to better serve the residents of the group home.

### EXPECTATIONS OF SPONSOR:

1. A commitment of two years
2. A cash or in-kind contribution of at least \$2,000/year
3. Provide volunteers for at least one work project during a twelve month period
4. Provide a designated contact person

### EXPECTATIONS OF THE KENNEDY CENTER:

1. Plan and implement one work project involving the sponsor during the twelve month period
2. Provide an ad in our newsletter Sharing for a period of two years, plus recognition in local newspapers
3. Provide the sponsor with a list of needs on a regular basis
4. The group home supervisor will serve as the primary contact.
